Charles Johnson Payne, known as Snaffles, was a British artist renowned for his equestrian and military-themed illustrations. Born in 1884, Snaffles captured the spirit of country life, hunting, and horse racing through his distinctive style, marked by vivid line work and soft water-colour washes. His work, often accompanied by humorous captions, celebrated rural sports and military life, making him a beloved figure in British sporting art. Snaffles' art remains highly regarded for its charm and authenticity.
