Description

Large Normandy faience tin-glazed serving bowl in typical Norman folk art style 1720-1760.

Tin glaze is a ceramic glazing technique involving a tin oxide mixture, which creates a glossy, opaque white finish on earthenware. Popular from the 16th century onwards, it enhances colour vibrancy and durability. This method, used in faience and majolica, results in a smooth, reflective surface ideal for detailed, hand-painted designs.
