Description

A 19th century copper and brass Moroccan dowry gador.

In Moroccan culture, *gadors* are containers for symbolic gifts included in the dowry during marriage negotiations. These carefully selected items typically include gold jewellery, luxurious fabrics, perfumes, sugar, henna, and dates.

The groom's family offers them to the bride as a gesture of love, prosperity, and respect. *Gadors* vary based on regional customs and financial means, reflecting Morocco's rich traditions. This cherished practice strengthens family bonds and honors marital commitments.
