Description

An elegant Edwardian cut-glass claret jug with its original matching stopper, dating from the early 20th century. Beautifully made in clear glass, the jug is decorated with crisp, light-catching cut detail that gives the piece a refined presence on the table, whether used for wine or displayed as part of a glass collection.

Its classical form is both decorative and practical, with a generously sized body for serving claret or other wines and a fitted stopper that completes the silhouette. The clean brilliance of the cut glass makes it especially effective in candlelight or on a formal dining table, where it brings a note of traditional English entertaining.

The stopper has some damage, reflected in the price and clearly visible in the photographs; however, it remains functional and the jug is still entirely usable. This is a charming and well-proportioned Edwardian serving piece with honest signs of age, ideal for regular use or display.
