

Edwardian Rose Gold, Garnet & Sapphire Necklace

Description

An elegant Edwardian 9ct rose gold necklace, dating to circa 1915, beautifully set with richly coloured almandine garnets and luminous white sapphires. The warmth of the rose gold provides a handsome contrast to the deep wine-red garnets, while the white sapphires add a delicate, light-catching brilliance that gives the piece a refined and romantic character.

Its graceful design reflects the lingering influence of Edwardian jewellery at the beginning of the 20th century: feminine, finely balanced, and intended to sit beautifully at the neckline. The alternating tones of warm gold, vivid garnet, and bright white sapphire give the necklace both depth and sparkle, allowing it to move effortlessly from daytime wear to an evening setting.

Almandine garnets have long been admired for their velvety red colour and enduring wearability, and here they provide a rich focal point against the soft blush tone of the gold. The white sapphires bring a crisp, understated shimmer, lending the necklace a pleasing sense of contrast without overwhelming its period elegance.

A charming and highly wearable antique jewel, ideal for collectors of Edwardian and early 20th-century jewellery or for anyone seeking a distinctive necklace with colour, history, and timeless appeal.
