Description

An Edwardian wreath brooch of silver leaves set with oval citrines, circa 1910.

Traditionally, wreaths represent continuity and eternity due to their unbroken, circular shape.

Citrines, with their warm, golden hues, symbolise abundance, success, and positivity in jewellery. Often referred to as the "stone of wealth," citrine is believed to attract prosperity and boost self-confidence. Its bright colour and clarity represent joy, energy, and vitality, making it a popular choice for pieces meant to inspire and uplift.

Additionally, citrine is thought to enhance creativity and personal power, imbuing jewellery with both aesthetic appeal and meaningful symbolism.
