Description

A beautifully elegant triple-strand pearl necklace, dating to circa 1960, composed of graduated cream-toned pearls with a soft, even lustre. The necklace is secured by an impressive 18ct gold clasp, generously set with sapphires and diamonds. The cool blue of the sapphires and bright sparkle of the diamonds provide a striking contrast to the warm cream tones of the pearls, transforming the clasp from a purely functional detail into a jewel in its own right. Worn to the front or side, it offers a wonderfully versatile focal point.

With its combination of classic pearls, colourful gemstones, and substantial gold work, this necklace captures the polished glamour of mid-century jewellery. It is equally suited to formal occasions and as an elegant statement piece with a simple evening dress or tailored ensemble.
