Rose gold, a blend of gold and copper, gained popularity in the 19th century. Its warm, pinkish hue was first used in Russian jewellery, known as "Russian gold." The metal's romantic, vintage appeal surged in the early 20th century, especially in Art Deco designs, and continues to be cherished in modern jewellery.
