Description

A charming 19th-century Victorian yellow-gold pearl star jewel, designed as a convertible brooch and pendant. Centred on a beautifully balanced starburst form, the piece is set with lustrous pearls that lend the design a soft, celestial radiance. Its finely worked yellow-gold mount provides a warm contrast to the creamy tones of the pearls, creating an elegant and distinctly Victorian jewel.

The removable fittings allow it to be worn in more than one way: as a brooch on a lapel, bodice, or scarf, or as a pendant suspended from a chain or ribbon. Such adaptable jewels were especially prized in the 19th century, when versatility formed an important part of a well-chosen jewellery collection.

Presented in its fitted box, the jewel has the added appeal of a complete and carefully preserved period presentation. The combination of star motif, pearl setting, convertible construction, and original case makes this an exceptionally attractive example of Victorian personal adornment.
