Description

A handsome 1940s square-form wall lantern with two internal light fittings, offering a strong architectural silhouette and the distinctive character of mid-20th-century lighting. Its clean, geometric form is both practical and decorative, making it an excellent choice for adding period warmth to an entrance hall, porch, stairwell, garden room, or covered exterior setting.

The lantern's square profile gives it a pleasingly restrained presence, while the twin-light arrangement provides a generous, even illumination. When lit, the paired fittings create depth and atmosphere within the lantern, highlighting its structure and allowing the form to read beautifully against a wall or doorway.

The lantern has been professionally rewired with twisted fabric flex, preserving its vintage appearance while making it ready for modern installation. It has also been PAT tested for electrical safety, providing additional reassurance for use in a contemporary setting.

A versatile and characterful piece of 1940s lighting, equally suited to a traditional country house, an industrial-inspired interior, or a more contemporary space seeking an authentic period detail. It would work particularly well as a statement light beside a front door, in pairs along a hallway, or as a decorative focal point in a covered outdoor area.
