Still Life with Chinese Porcelain Ginger Jar and Fruit

A refined signed oil on canvas by the renowned French artist Jean Grimal, depicting an elegant arrangement of fruit beside a Chinese porcelain ginger jar. Carefully composed and quietly atmospheric, the work demonstrates Grimal's accomplished handling of colour, light, and surface, bringing a painterly richness to this classical still-life subject.

At the centre of the composition, the porcelain jar provides a decorative focal point, its distinctive form and ornament offering a beautiful contrast to the organic shapes and warm tones of the surrounding fruit. The artist balances these elements with a sensitive awareness of texture and tonal variation, allowing the glazed ceramic, fruit, and background to each retain their individual character while forming a harmonious whole.

Grimal's approach gives the familiar still-life tradition a distinctly modern sensibility. His controlled yet expressive brushwork and subtle palette create both intimacy and visual depth, making this a work that rewards close viewing. The painting is signed by the artist and retains an exhibition label on the reverse, further enhancing its appeal to collectors.

A handsome and decorative example of late 20th-century French painting, equally suited to a traditional interior or a more contemporary setting. An excellent opportunity to acquire a signed work by Jean Grimal, whose evocative still lifes remain admired for their colour, composition, and enduring charm.
