Whist markers are devices or tools used to track scores and progression in the classic card game of Whist. Traditionally, they are small, portable items made of wood, ivory, or metal, featuring rotating dials or sliders to display scores clearly. Whist markers ensure fair play by recording scores accurately and were a staple of Victorian-era gaming tables. Modern versions may include digital counters, but the classic markers remain cherished collector's items for enthusiasts of traditional games.
