Omega, founded in 1848 by Louis Brandt in La Chaux-de-Fonds, Switzerland, began as a small watch assembly workshop. Renamed Omega in 1903, it gained fame for its precision and innovation. Omega watches have been used in numerous iconic moments, including NASA's Apollo 11 moon landing in 1969, as the official Olympic timekeeper since 1932, and James Bond's favourite timepiece since 1995. Known for craftsmanship, Omega remains a symbol of luxury and technological excellence in watch making.
