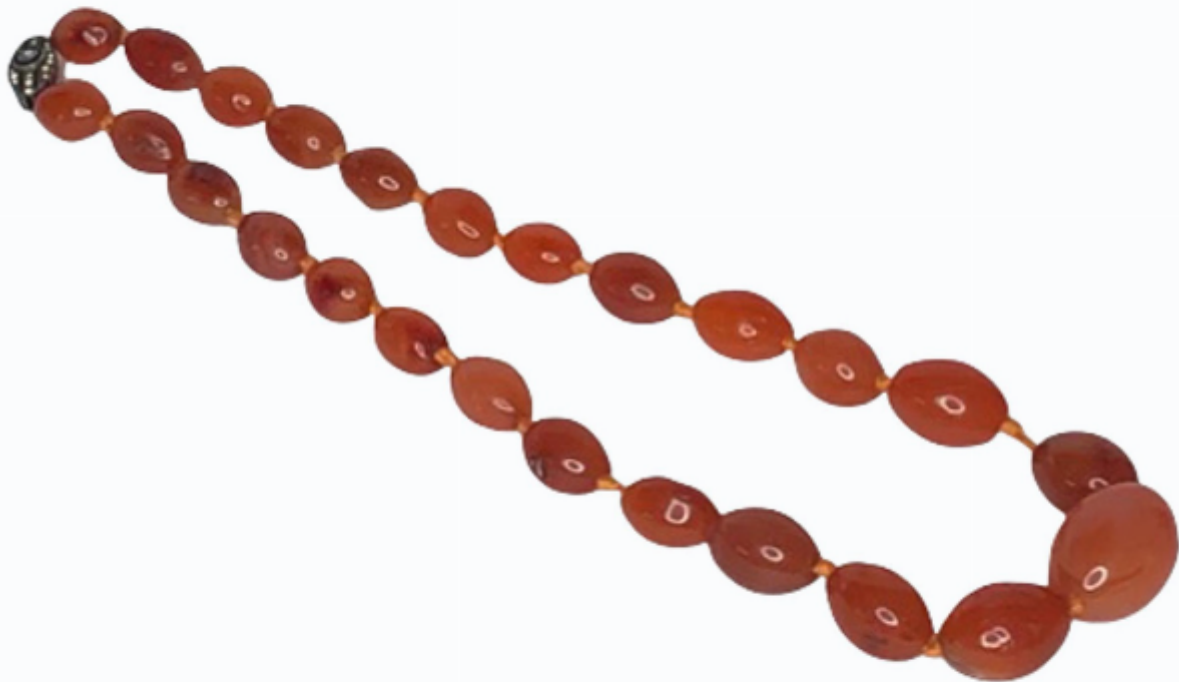


A 1930s single oval shape cornelian beads with silver Art Deco clasp
