Description

An elegant single-strand pearl necklace dating from the 1920s, finished with a refined white-gold clasp set with diamonds. Understated yet luxurious, it is a beautiful example of the enduring appeal of pearls during the Art Deco period, when fine jewellery favoured clean lines, luminous materials, and carefully balanced proportions.

The graduated strand of pearls has a soft, flattering lustre, creating the classic fluid silhouette that has made pearl necklaces an essential part of a well-considered jewellery collection for generations. At the reverse, the white-gold and diamond-set clasp provides a discreet yet sparkling finishing detail. Its cool-toned setting complements the pearls beautifully, adding a touch of 1920s glamour without disturbing the necklace's elegant simplicity.

During the 1920s, pearls became closely associated with modern femininity and sophisticated evening dress. Worn with everything from daywear to cocktail and formal attire, a single strand offered a polished, versatile style that remains as relevant today as it was a century ago.
