

French Art Deco Diamond Plaque Ring, Circa 1925

Description

A refined French Art Deco diamond plaque ring, dating to circa 1925. This elegant jewel is centred with three old brilliant-cut diamonds, arranged within a geometric plaque and framed by a surround of eight-cut diamonds. Together, the stones create a lively field of light, combining the softer character of early brilliant cuts with the crisp sparkle of the smaller accent diamonds.

The rectangular plaque design is quintessentially Art Deco, its symmetry and clean linear arrangement reflecting the sophisticated modernism of French jewellery in the 1920s. The diamond-set top is carried on a 14ct gold shank, providing a warm contrast to the brilliance of the stones and making the ring especially wearable.

French Art Deco rings of this period are prized for their balance of ornament and geometry, and this example captures that aesthetic with particular charm. Delicate enough for everyday wear yet striking in its design, it would make a beautiful engagement ring, anniversary gift, or addition to a collection of antique diamond jewellery.
