Carl Deffner (1856-1948) was a German industrialist and entrepreneur, known for founding a metalware manufacturing company in Esslingen am Neckar, Germany. The Carl Deffner company specialised in crafting high-quality household items, including copper and brass utensils, cookware, and decorative pieces.

Renowned for their fine craftsmanship, Deffner's designs often featured Arts & Crafts, Art Nouveau and Jugendstil influences. His products gained international recognition during the late 19th and early 20th centuries, reflecting a legacy of innovation and aesthetic excellence.
