Description

A handsome pair of Edwardian silver-plate candlesticks, dating to circa 1905. Elegantly proportioned and richly detailed with vertical reeding, they embody the restrained sophistication and classical influence of early 20th-century tableware.

Each candlestick rises from a broad, weighted circular base, its clean silhouette enhanced by crisp fluted ornament. The reeded columns lead to neatly formed capitals and candle sockets, creating a pleasing balance of decorative detail and architectural simplicity. Their bright silver-plated finish catches the candlelight beautifully, making them especially effective for a dining table, mantelpiece, console, or sideboard.

Made during the Edwardian period, these candlesticks reflect a continued taste for formal entertaining and carefully considered interiors. Their classical shape allows them to sit comfortably within both traditional and more contemporary settings, while the paired format offers immediate symmetry and impact.

A versatile and attractive pair for dining, entertaining, or display, they would make a stylish addition to a collection of antique silver plate, an elegant table setting, or an interior seeking the warmth of candlelight and the refinement of the Edwardian era.
